Hospice care

1 in 4 dying Americans is a veteran, and we believe that every veteran deserves a peaceful ending. The care our teams provide extends beyond the patient to the family and other caregivers to ensure the very best end-of-life experience possible.

Hospice care is the model for quality, compassionate care for people facing serious illnesses or injuries who are expected to live six months or less.

Our goal is to engage veterans facing serious illness and their families sooner, improving quality of life well before the end.

Compassionate care teams of board-certified physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, certified nursing assistants, social workers, counselors, chaplains and volunteers provide:

- Expert pain management
- Care coordination with your other health providers
- Medication management
- Personal care
- Spiritual care
- Respite for the family and companionship for the patient
- Grief counseling and bereavement services for patients, families and other loved ones
- 24/7 phone support

All services are delivered wherever a patient calls home: a family residence, a nursing home, an assisted living facility, an inpatient unit or hospital.

More than Traditional Hospice

Hosparus Health has expanded our home-based services beyond traditional hospice care to include palliative and advanced illness care. Unlike hospice, which is limited to the last six months of life, palliative care is appropriate at any age and at any stage of a serious illness. It can be provided alongside treatment intended to cure your disease.

Palliative care focuses on improving care coordination, better management of treatments and medications, assistance with daily living, and better access to social services and counseling for patients with a difficult-to-manage chronic illness.

How do I pay for services?

Medicare, Medicaid, and many insurance plans cover 100% of hospice services.

Plus, all veterans enrolled in the VA's healthcare system are eligible for hospice and palliative care. Benefits coverage generally provides for necessary medication, medical equipment and supplies.
