Hospice Care

One in four Americans who dies each year is a veteran. We believe every veteran deserves comfort, dignity, and peace at the end of life.

Hospice care is compassionate, high-quality support for people facing serious illness or injury who are expected to live six months or less. Our care extends beyond the patient to include families and caregivers, ensuring the best possible end-of-life experience.

We encourage veterans and their families to reach out early so we can help improve quality of life well before the final days.

Compassionate Care Teams

Our teams include board-certified physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, certified nursing assistants, social workers, counselors, chaplains, and trained volunteers. Together, they provide:

- Expert pain and symptom management
- Coordination with your other healthcare providers
- Medication support and guidance
- Help with bathing, dressing, and other personal care needs
- Spiritual and emotional support
- Respite for families and companionship for patients
- Grief counseling and bereavement services for patients and loved ones
- 24/7 access to phone support

Care is provided wherever the patient lives, including private homes, nursing homes, assisted living facilities, hospitals, and inpatient centers.

Care Beyond Hospice

Hosparus Health also offers palliative and advanced illness care for veterans who may not yet be eligible for hospice.

Palliative care provides an extra layer of support for people living with serious illness. It can begin at any age and be provided alongside treatments aimed at curing or managing disease.

This care helps ease symptoms, simplify care decisions, and provide support with daily tasks, emotional wellbeing, and access to social services. Our team works closely with your existing providers to reduce stress and help care feel more manageable.

How to Pay for Care

Medicare, Medicaid, and many insurance plans cover the full cost of hospice care.

Veterans enrolled in the VA healthcare system are also eligible for hospice and palliative care. Coverage often includes medications, medical equipment, and supplies.
