Hospice Care

Hospice is compassionate, high-quality care for people living with serious illness and a life expectancy of six months or less.

Hosparus Health is the region's leading nonprofit hospice provider, serving communities across Kentucky and Indiana.

Each patient and family receives care from a dedicated team that may include your physician, a Hosparus Health physician, nurse practitioner, registered nurse, social worker, certified nursing assistant, spiritual counselor, and trained volunteer.

Our goal is to improve quality of life by managing pain and symptoms and providing expert support for patients and their families.

Services We Provide

Our care teams offer:

- Relief from pain, nausea, trouble breathing, and restlessness
- Medication management
- Help with personal care like bathing, eating, and hygiene
- Coordination with your primary care provider or other clinicians
- Support with advance care planning
- Spiritual and emotional care
- Respite for families and companionship for patients
- Grief counseling and bereavement support for patients and families
- 24/7 phone support from our clinical team

Hospice care is most often provided in the home. It may also be available in a nursing home, assisted living facility, hospital, or inpatient care facility within our service area.

Inpatient Care Center

If symptoms become difficult to manage at home, our Inpatient Care Center offers short-term care in a hospital-level setting. Once symptoms are under control, the patient may return home or transition to another care setting with continued support from the Hosparus Health team.

Payment Options

Medicare, Medicaid, and most insurance plans cover 100% of hospice services. In addition to your care team, coverage typically includes medications, medical equipment, and supplies related to the hospice diagnosis.

Who Can Make a Referral

Anyone can contact Hosparus Health to start the process. We will follow up with the patient's physician to determine eligibility.

When to Call for Hospice Support

If your patient or loved one is experiencing any of the following, we may be able to help:

- Increased pain, nausea, or breathing distress
- Frequent hospitalizations or ER visits
- Delayed recovery after medical setbacks
- Difficulty walking, eating, bathing, dressing, or using the bathroom
- Sleeping more or showing less interest in conversation or surroundings
- Noticeable weight loss or reduced appetite
